

TRINITY'S EMERGENCY FUND plays a role in helping people make it through tough times. *Thank you, Trinity members, for your generous support. We manage your gifts*, first, by interviewing the person to determine the need; second, by assessing the legitimacy/urgency of the need; third, by referring them to agencies like Center of Concern,

Lutheran Social Services, Maine Township Assistance, and WINGS, many of which are supported by our congregation; and fourth, by providing help from Trinity if they have exhausted all other options available to them. We may provide a Jewel Card for food, gasoline from a nearby gas station, a prescription at a nearby pharmacy or transportation on Metra or the CTA. It is not our policy to give cash, since we determine the need and seek to meet it with appropriate assistance. Our goal is to manage faithfully the resources given by the people of Trinity Lutheran Church so that real needs may be met and that people are treated with dignity and respect.
